


# Safety Update

## **Current Programs**



#### WeTip2.0

The program implementation with school sites is near completion – Official launch date November 1

- User accounts have been created for designated CVESD staff
- Currently testing program and developing training



### **Security Assessments**

48 Security and Vulnerability assessments have been completed

- CVLCC Elementary (10/19/23) and Bayfront High School (10/20/23)
- The Sobel group is creating a report for all school sites with an estimated completion date of November 2023



## **Security Preparedness**

#### Lockdown drills

### **Training**

- Active Shooter/Critical response Prof. Dev. Training for school sites
- Emergency Response Procedure training for new staff and ELOP Site Leads

## **Security Managers**

### **Emergency Preparedness & Security Manager**

- Assist and evaluate school training exercises and drills
- Train school site staff on emergency exercises
- Coordinate and participate in meetings
- Organize and coordinate external support to provide resources in an emergency

#### Security Program and Safety Operations Manager

- Maintain CSSP plans for each school site
- Seek grant opportunities, prepare budgets, and manage projects
- Develop and evaluate emergency training exercises
- Conduct, facilitate, and oversee Community Townhall meetings
- Present at board meetings


